

2011 Greenville Farm Market Rules

1. All vendors MUST be registered with the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce or the Market Master. The Market is located at Greenville's Veteran's Park.
2. All vendors must be permanent residents of: Montcalm County, Grattan, Oakfield, Spencer, Otisco, Orleans Townships, or Belding. Permanent spots will be given to seasonal pass holders when passes are purchased. Others will receive designated spots (issued by Market Masters) based on availability.
3. Items permitted for sale at the Market are limited to **homegrown** produce, fruit, flowers, and plants; and **handmade** jams/jellies, bread and baked goods (must be produced in a commercially-licensed kitchen). **Cheese is allowed, but must be pasteurized and kept refrigerated at 41 degrees or lower, as required by the MI Dept. of Agriculture.**
4. Items personally handmade and homegrown will be clearly marked as such with signage provided. If you are buying and reselling your products, a sign will be provided to you. CUSTOMERS HAVE ASKED THAT THIS BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED BY OUR VENDORS.
5. * Questionable items must be approved by the Greenville Community Farm & Home Market committee prior to sale.
6. NON-CHAMBER MEMBER GROWERS THAT OWN A STOREFRONT BUSINESS BASED ON THEIR FARM ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED.
7. All items as well as weights and measures are subject to inspection and approval by the Michigan Department of Agriculture.
8. **The Greenville Community Farm & Home Market committee reserves the right to make unannounced garden inspections.**
9. Purchase of seasonal pass prior to June 14th (market opens June 14th) should be made at the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce. Weekly space after June 14th must be registered and paid to the Market Master or a member of the Greenville Community Farm & Home Market Committee.
10. The Committee reserves the right to waive/negotiate fees in the case of civic/non-profits groups, to be considered on a case-by-case basis.
11. Spaces are approximately 10' X 20' marked parking spaces. *When parking spaces are filled, vendors may set up a table on the basketball court. **VEHICLES ARE PROHIBED ON THE COURT. ALL PRODUCT WILL BE HAND-TRUCKED OR CARRIED. VENDORS SELLING FROM A TABLE ON THE BASKETBALL COURT SHALL PARK ON THE STREET.** Multiple spaces may be purchased on the basis of availability and subject to payment of appropriate fees. Daily fees shall be collected by the Market Master or member of the Greenville Community Farm & Home Market Committee.
12. Fee for farm and food items is \$90.00 per space for the season (June 14 – October) or \$7.00 per space per week. Fees for crafters will be \$100.00 per space for the season or \$10.00 per space per week. **Fees are not refundable.**
13. Weekly or seasonal passes **MUST** be visible and displayed at all times.
14. Season pass holders have priority in choosing their space assignment based on seniority, or disability. Their space is held for them until 7:45 AM. After that time, spaces are assigned on a first come first served basis.
